Screening for Leaders & Volunteers

Screening is required for all adults working in any positions of trust within 4-H Alberta. Did you complete volunteer / leader screening? If so, thank you! If not, then please go ahead and do it now. We are still open.

Screening and training for 4-H Alberta leaders and volunteers carries on and we encourage you to complete all screening and training components. Although we do have a deadline

near the start of each 4-H year, screening may proceed year-round and now is a fine time for our valuable volunteers to be proactive and complete the online screening components as well as all online training.

Leaders and volunteers can download the <u>Tip Sheet for Leaders & Volunteers</u>. It helps you to navigate the 4-H Alberta Online Registration System where you can update your profile, check on your screening progress, register for programs, and more. If you note that your references did not all respond, the tip sheet shows you how to send out the reference link. Another helpful, downloadable document is the <u>Leader Screening Instructions and Tips sheet</u>. If you can't find your log in data, need a current police check letter or assistance, please email <u>leaderscreening@4hab.com</u> or call Bernadette directly at 780-898-3037.

A few things to remember:

- You must mail in your original police check. *Please note that police detachments may not be providing this non-essential service at this time. However, do proceed with the other screening and training components. Once you have a police check, we recommend that you first send an image via email. Mail original police checks to 4-H Council of Alberta, RR 1 Site 7 Box 1, WESTEROSE, AB TOC 2VO. Enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope if you want the original returned.
- While you can download the police check letter while you are within the
 online application form, that version may be outdated. Email Bernadette
 at leaderscreening@4hab.com for a more recent copy of it. The letter is
 not available as a general download as it cannot be used for any purposes
 other than volunteering 4-H Alberta. Any use for other purposes, such
 as employment, jeopardizes our membership with Volunteer Alberta, the
 organization that subsidizes the free or reduced fee acquisition of the police
 check for our volunteers.
- Fingerprinting is not uncommon and occurs if you share a name, birthdate or
 other similarity with a known offender. If your police check was delayed due
 to fingerprinting or other reasons, do remember to follow up with the police
 detachment and email leaderscreeening@4hab.com to have the extension
 noted to your file.

4-H Supervision Policy

<u>Rule of Two</u> - the purpose of this policy is to protect youth members, leaders, volunteers, and staff in potentially vulnerable situations. The goal is to achieve the "Green Standard" for all 4-H programming.

What is the "Green Standard"? The standard which is our goal is to always have 2 (two) trained, screened leaders present whenever interacting with 1 (one) or more 4-H youth.

While, at this time, we may not be meeting with members or others in person, please remember that the 4-H policies and rules still apply to all contact with members, whether the contact is with one or more members. All communications and online contacts with one or more 4-H members require that there be a minimum of two adults present. Communications may include phone calls, emails, texts or any other online or other methods of contact. Ideally, two fully screened and trained leaders would be present and/or included for ALL communications. If that is not possible, then one trained, screened leader and a screened volunteer would be a good option. Finally, one trained, screened leader along with a guest, such as a parent, will suffice. So, to all 4-H Alberta leaders in contact with one or more members:

- when emailing and/or texting and/or any other online communicating, make sure to copy another leader and direct member(s) to "REPLY ALL" when responding;
- when conducting any online meetings, ensure that another leader,
 volunteer or parent is also present throughout the communication;
- phone calls must also include another leader or adult so conference calling, calling the parent(s) and having them remain on line, or placing the calls while on speaker with the two adults present is required.

Commit to Kids Training for Leaders & Volunteers

Commit to Kids training is required for all adults working in any positions of trust within 4-H Alberta.

Did you complete Commit to Kids training? If so, thank you!! You rock! If not, then please go ahead and do it all now. Online training is still open.

In partnership with 4-H Canada, 4-H Alberta offers key training in **Abuse Prevention** and **Duty to Report**. The training is **now** mandatory for all 4-H Alberta staff, leaders and board members and must be completed in addition to the screening process. We encourage every leader and volunteer to access this training now if you have not already done so. The training is optional for volunteers but is strongly encouraged. We invite you to participate now to increase your awareness and to learn how to take a proactive role in ensuring that our 4-H children and youth remain safe and protected. The training is **free** to all 4-H volunteers, leaders, staff and board members. Commit to Kids training becomes mandatory across Canada in May, 2021.

4-H Alberta and 4-H Canada share a priority to ensure that all children and youth who participate in 4-H programs and activities are safe and protected from harm. Commit to Kids is a program that helps organizations create safe environments for children. It provides policies, strategies, and step-by-step plans for reducing the risk of child sexual abuse, encouraging organizations to take an active, participatory role in protecting children in their care. Commit to Kids was developed by the Canadian Centre for Child Protection. The online training provides best practices to increase the personal safety of children and youth.

Commit to Kids training has already been completed by many and successful completion of the training is recorded in leaders' and volunteers' profiles in the online registration system. Right now, leaders and volunteers can find further details and instructions for accessing the training via the 4h.ab.ca website and can download detailed instructions here.
