Alberta Youth Quarter Horse Association (AYQHA) and Quarter Horse Association of Alberta (QHAA) is offering a new program for youth who want to give showing a try. This year, one youth per show will have their show fees covered by QHAA and be connected with a trainer (chosen by AYQHA and QHAA). The youth will get two lessons from their trainer and will be stalled with them at the show.

Interested youth will submit video or written entries explaining their horse industry goals and what this opportunity means to them. They must also provide a video of themselves riding the horse they wish to show. The youth will be

responsible for having their own transportation, accommodations, tack, and proper show clothes.

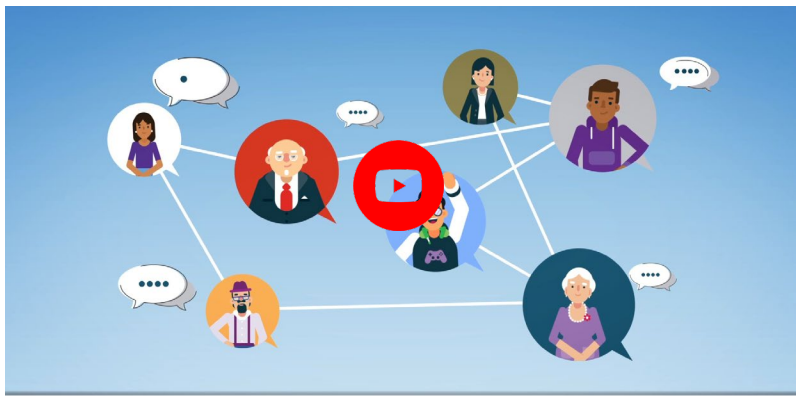
