

The Youth Water Council is another great, innovative, and relevant initiative that Alberta's 4-H'ers participated in this year! The Youth Water Council is made up of 10 senior 4-H members (age 15-19) who live in central Alberta. To take on the challenge of raising awareness of temporary water diversion licenses (TDLs) and their importance, they met with experts to learn about water regulation, environmental science, and communications. The Council learned about temporary diversion licenses or TDLs from both experts and landowners. Then they planned and created a video and infographics to raise awareness.
