- Register your projects with club/district/regional committees as required - (weights, visual tags & CCIA #'s.)
- Order Resources - inserts, membership cards. Staples EPrint Site: go to>4-H Members Need>Basic Project Supplies.
- Prepare a sheet for members to list projects at the beginning of the year. All projects and descriptions are listed on the 4-H Alberta Sheep Standards - <https://www.4hab.com/profile/sheep/>
- Go through Sheep Standards and any other Sheep Committee Rules in your Club/District or Region.
- Go through with members and parents club rules for the Sheep project in your club,
- Build a list of local lamb producers for members to source lambs from.

### What Club Leaders need to know

- Refer to and talk about the 4-H Alberta Sheep Standards often.
- Always check rules - Sheep Committee or any level that affects you.
- Fill out an activity form for field trips etc.
- Provincial opportunities - Lamb Carcass & Provincial Sheep Show.
